The wine list

Wines highlighted in blue are especially recommended as they were selected during our 2012 visit to Burgundy and our tastings at the Puligny–Montrachet 'cave' of the world-renowned Olivier Leflaive and in the candle-lit cellars of the charming Cyrot brothers, Olivier and Marc-Emmanuel, in Pommard. We walked in the vineyards in the autumn sun, chatted to the winemakers in our poor French and their better English, and drank their best wine, all for your sake. Some of our personal favourites of the wines appear below for you to enjoy too.

Wines highlighted in green come from our visit in 2013 to the cellars of La Tunella, nestling beside the Alpine foothills of Friuli. We loved these for the rich flavour and distinctive character of truly native Italian wine varieties, in contrast to the bland "zesty citrus" of so much Italian wine. Delizioso!

Wines highlighted in yellow come from our 2014 visit to Bordeaux and in particular to the 11th century Chateau De Lamarque

Wines highlighted in red come from our 2015 visit to the Cotes du Rhone. From the wonderful reds of the Gonnet family to the eminently drinkable Tavel Rose and the superlative Hermitage of Tardieu-Laurent..... Enjoy!

1. Pinot Grigio La Tunella 2015 Friuli, Italy

£27.00

And by the half bottle £16.50

A Pinot Grigio with depth, elegance and a real freshness - "Solid, spicy wine that is a little reminiscent of Alsace with a hint of saltiness. Proper wine." – Jancis Robinson.

2. Sauvignon Blanc, Vina Mar de Casablanca, Reserva, 2015 Chile

£27.00

Intense but delicate aroma and great purity of fruit characterise this delicious sauvignon blanc - grapefruit and fresh cut grass balanced by fine refreshing acidity

3. Rheingau Riesling Qba Schloss Schonborn 2013

£33.00

Fresh grape character, beguiling aromatics and complementary minerality - versatile and very attractive. A proper German Riesling!

4. Friulano La Tunella 2014 Friuli, Italy

£32.00

This dry white, is delicately harmonious, with a fruity bouquet and a note of bitter almond, pear, wild flowers and acacia. The palate is smooth and velvety, moderately acid, dry and well structured.

5. Sancerre, Domaine du Nozay 2015, France

£43.00

And by the half bottle £28.00

Multi-award winning Sancerre from passionate, winemaking family dedicated solely to the pursuit of making perfect Sauvignon Blanc

6. Auxey-Duresses, Olivier Leflaive, 2013, Burgundy, France

£50.00

This wonderful chardonnay comes from vines lying along the same slopes as those of the more famous Mersault. A perfect example of the best in white Burgundy village appellations.

Rosé

19. Tavel Tardieu Laurent 2014

£33.00

One of the world's best Roses, this top biodynamic offering by Tardieu is from the famous Rhone town where they only make pink wines. And so they should: with free-draining lime/iron-rich soils, these serious Roses are deep-coloured, full-bodied and textured, showing subtle earthy-mineral complexity through the delicate fruit depth and refreshing acidity. A pure delight - but one for the dinner table, not as an aperitif !

9. Pinot Noir, Bourgogne, Domaine Cyrot-Buthiau 2013, Burgundy France

£30.00

Our secret from meeting the Cyrot brothers – the vines making this lovely Burgundy were originally classified as fully-fledged Volnay vines, and in the view of many, still could be. A step up from your average red Burgundy!

10. Cabernet Franc, La Tunella 2014 Friuli, Italy

£31.00

Dry red. Intense ruby red colour. The scent ranges from red berries to the grassiness typical of the variety, set against a background hint of flamed wood. The palate is ethereal and elegant, with great character, and a generous, pleasant body

11 Cotes du Rhone Vignobles Gonnet 2014

£31.00

Grenache blend, 'Rhone in a bottle' from innovative wine makers Vignoble Gonnet

12. Chateau De Lamarque 2012, Haut Medoc, Bordeaux, France

£39.00

Our visit to Bordeaux in 2014, where Pierre Gilles Gromand d'Evry is the seventh generation of his family making delicious Cru Bourgeois claret at his mediaeval castle, just outside Margaux. He and his wife, the elegant Marie-Helene are absolutely devoted to making a wine that can challenge the local Grand Cru Classes.

13. Pommard Domaine Cyrot-Buthiau 2011 , Burgundy, France

£57.50

Delicate cherry fruit and dark spice, combined with floral and earthy notes, the texture is silky and extremely elegant.

Sparkling

14. Prosecco, Barocco Brut NV, Veneto, Italy
£30.00

Light, fresh and dry sparkling wine from Northern Italy. Lemon Sherbet flavours dominate with a clean mousse and crisp finish. Perfect summer aperitif.

15. Perrier-Jouet Brut Premier NV, Champagne, France
£60.00

Perrier-Jouet produces one of the greatest and most complex NV's from Champagne. It is the perfect combination of powerful and elegant fruit enhanced by its 4 years of bottle age.

7. Puligny-Montrachet 1er Cru Les Referts, Olivier Leflaive 2011, France

£69.00

Fine, premier cru white Burgundy from the finest of the white Burgundy villages, Puligny. Because you're worth it

8. Hermitage Blanc, Tardieu Laurent 2010

£89.50

Light yellow-gold. Deeply pitched aromas of poached pear and lemon curd, with powerful honey and anise accents. Supple and broad, offering weighty flavours and hints of marzipan and chamomile. Shows very impressive power and intensity on clinging finish.

Pudding

16. Chateau Septy, Monbazillac 2009, France (37.5 cl)
£20.00

Classic pudding wine from the Dordogne suffused with aromas of dried fruits, honey and flowers.

17. Chateau Briatte, Sauternes 2009 France (37.5 cl)
£30.00

A very luscious and rich Sauternes sauternes with concentrated flavours of honeyed apricot, honeycomb, a touch of toffee and spice.

18. Noans, La Tunella, Friuli, 2010, Italy (50 cl)

£40.25

An intriguing blend of equal parts Gewurztraminer (Traminer Aromatico), Sauvignon Blanc & Riesling that delivers a deeply complex, lush and opulent glass of pudding wine.
