## 1. Il Carretto IGT Bianco di Sicilia, 2015, Italy £18.50

This soft, lively Sicilian white offers distinctive citrus flavours with hints of herb and almond.

## 2. Unoaked Chardonnay, El Campesino 2015, Chile £19.00

A fresh Chardonnay, with tropical and citrus fruit balanced with rich and smooth buttery notes and a hint of vanilla on the finish.

## 6. Shiraz, Puertas Antiguas, Chile 2016 £23.00

Produced by the highly respected winery, Luis Filipe Edwards, this is a well-crafted, quite refined style of Shiraz so removed from the big, flashy Australian style from the Barossa. The wine delivers warm and rich dark fruits on the nose with touches of mocca and toast on the periphery balanced with a soft, rounded medium bodied palate and length.
